NETWORK DASHBOARD

What is the Network Dashboard?

The Network Dashboard shows a table of connections between devices connected to the network and the services they connect to, along with the recorded average time required to establish that connection.

WHY USE THE **NETWORK DASHBOARD** FEATURE?

- Easier to read the links between network-connected devices and services,
- the ability to read the time required to fulfill a connection,
- the ability to quickly and easily locate problems with network-connected devices,
- transparent reading of network scanner functioning with graphically presented views,
- freedom to filter devices connected to the network,
- easier finding free connections between devices and services.

FOUR CONNECTION STATUSES

OK — Active connection to the service and connection time does not exceed the threshold value.

FREE — Active connection to the service, but the connection time exceeds the threshold value.

DISCONNECTED — No active connection to the service. The displayed time value is the last historical value for which a connection was obtained.

UNAVAILABLE — No active connection to the service. The displayed time value is the last historical value for which a connection was obtained.
